U.S. Capitol Police Arrest Demonstrators in U.S. Capitol Rotunda

WASHINGTON, DC – Today the United States Capitol Police arrested 12 individuals in the Rotunda of the U.S. Capitol. They were charged under D.C. Code § 22-1307, Crowding, Obstructing, or Incommoding, and were processed as non-mass arrests.

On the East Front Plaza, approximately 130 individuals were arrested for unlawful demonstration activity as part of the week's ongoing demonstrations. The arrestees were charged under D.C. Code § 22-1307, Crowding, Obstructing, or Incommoding. They are being processed on the scene and released.

Individuals who were arrested and are looking to pay their fines may do so at U.S. Capitol Police Headquarters, 119 D Street, NE. The Prisoners Processing Section is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
