U.S. Capitol Police Arrest Approximately 300 Demonstrators at U.S. Capitol

WASHINGTON, DC – Today on the East Front Rotunda Steps of the U.S. Capitol, United States Capitol Police (USCP) arrested approximately 300 individuals for unlawful demonstration activities. The arrestees were charged under D.C. Code § 22-1307, Crowding, Obstructing, or Incommoding. They were processed on the scene and released.

Approximately 1,240 arrests have been made by USCP since April 11 in association with the ongoing demonstrations.

Individuals who were arrested and are looking to pay their fines may do so at U.S. Capitol Police Headquarters, 119 D Street, NE. The Prisoners Processing Section is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
