R/O observed a vehicle strike a parked box truck while traveling westbound in the 200 block of Maryland Avenue, NE. R/O conducted a traffic stop in the same location. Upon approach, R/O detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the vehicle, and observed the Suspect holding a clear bottle half-full of a brown liquid. SFSTs were conducted and, due to numerous signs of impairment, the Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. A search of the Suspect's vehicle yielded a backpack containing a pipe commonly associated with drug use. CSS responded and processed the scene.
