R/O was alerted by an LPR hit of a stolen vehicle located at Third Street and Independence Avenue, SW. R/O located the vehicle traveling eastbound in the 500 block of Pennsylvania Avenue, occupied by two Suspects. A WALES/NCIC check of the vehicle tag was confirmed stolen. A traffic stop was conducted in the 1100 block of Pennsylvania Avenue, SE. A WALES/NCIC check of the driver revealed an expired permit, an extraditable warrant through Maryland State Police, and pending offenses for auto theft and simple assault against a family member. While conducting an inventory search of the passenger, R/O-2 located a weapon on the Suspect's left wrist. CSS responded and processed the scene. The Suspects were placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: FUGITIVE FROM JUSTICE

R/O observed a vehicle parked in the unit block of H Street, NW, matching the description of a vehicle wanted in reference to a missing person. The vehicle hit on an LPR a few days earlier. A WALES/NCIC check of the vehicle revealed the owner was subject to an active extraditable warrant for kidnapping. While conducting a preliminary investigation, R/O observed the Suspect approaching the vehicle with a small child. A WALES/NCIC check revealed the Suspect to be the owner of the vehicle. USCP Communications confirmed the warrant and the identity of the child. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
