R/O responded to the unit block of Massachusetts Avenue, NE, to investigate the report of a vehicle being operated with stolen tags. R/O observed the vehicle traveling eastbound in the unit block of

Massachusetts Avenue, NE. A WALES/NCIC check of the vehicle's tags revealed they were reported stolen. R/O conducted a traffic stop in the 500 block of C Street, NE. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. CSS responded and processed the scene. While in custody at USCP Headquarters, the Suspect stated the identification she presented did not belong to her, then provided the correct information. A WALES/NCIC check of the Suspect's identification revealed an active and extraditable warrant from Fairfax County, Virginia, and a license suspension through the State of Maryland. The suspect was charged with the additional offenses and further processed.
