R/O observed a vehicle with an inoperable right headlight traveling eastbound in the 100 block of E Street, NW. A traffic stop was conducted in the unit block of E Street, NW. During the stop, the

Suspect made several attempts to reach for an object between the driver's seat and center console. R/O had the Suspect step out of the vehicle and asked if he could conduct a search of the vehicle, to which the Suspect consented. During the search, R/O discovered four bags containing a white, rock-like substance, and one baggie containing a white, powdery substance. R/O asked the Suspect if she had any drugs on her person. The Suspect reached into her pockets and removed two small bags containing white, rock-like substances.
