ADDITIONAL CHARGES: RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY UNDER \$1000; WARRANT-PAROLE VIOLATION

While on patrol, R/O received an LPR hit for a stolen vehicle located at North Capitol and H Streets, NW. R/O observed a vehicle in the unit block of Columbus Circle, NE, matching the vehicle description. R/O confirmed through USCP Communications the tag on the vehicle was stolen and initiated a traffic stop in the 500 block of C Street, NE. A WALES/NCIC check of the driver revealed no valid permit in Maryland, Virginia, or the District of Columbia, and an active warrant issued by the DC Superior Court for Parole Violation.
