R/O observed a vehicle approach a security checkpoint at New Jersey Avenue and D Street, SE. As the driver did not provide the required credential to enter the perimeter, R/O denied access. The Suspect was given verbal commands to reverse their vehicle. The Suspect did not comply and drove the vehicle forward striking an officer. R/O-2 gave multiple commands to the Suspect to turn off the vehicle and step out. The Suspect did not comply and was removed from the vehicle. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY - \$1000 & OVER FELONY; UUV-FELONY

R/Os observed a vehicle matching a lookout and traveling without tags in the 200 block of Second Street, SE. A traffic stop was conducted in the same location. The Suspect became evasive and failed to provide a valid driver's permit. R/O conducted a vehicle identification check through NCIC/WALES, and it revealed that the vehicle was stolen. CSS responded, processed the vehicle, and recovered several items related to a possible burglary. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
