ADDITIONAL CHARGES: TRAFFIC - MISUSE OF TAGS; UCSA - POSSESSION (OTHER)

R/O responded to the unit block of E Street, NE, to investigate a vehicle involved in a traffic crash. A WALES/NCIC check of the Driver's license revealed a suspended status in both Maryland and the District of Columbia. Further investigation revealed that the displayed tag belonged to a different vehicle. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. A search incident to arrest recovered plastic bags containing a brown, powdery substance. The substances were field tested, and yielded positive results for methadone and cocaine.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: RECIEVING STOLEN PROPERTY \$1000 OR MORE; UNLAWFUL ENTRY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE; POSSESSION W/I TO DISTRIBUTE A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE; TRAFFIC - NO VALID PERMIT; POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE-MISD; POSSESSION W/I TO DISTRIBUTE MARIJUANA-MISD

R/O received an LPR hit for a stolen vehicle at North Capitol and H Streets, NW, which was confirmed through USCP Communications. R/O observed a vehicle matching the description in the 400 block of Second Street, NW. A traffic stop was conducted in the same location. A WALES/NCIC check of the Driver revealed he did not possess a valid permit in Maryland, Virginia, or the District of Columbia. During a search of the Suspect, R/O recovered a large, white, rock wrapped in a plastic bag. During a search of the Passenger, R/O recovered a small baggy containing a white, powdery substance. During an administrative search of the vehicle, R/O discovered three large "knots" of a green, leafy substance. The substances were field tested, which yielded a positive result for methamphetamines and marijuana. The Suspects were placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
