R/O observed multiple individuals engaged in demonstration activity in room 2045 of the Rayburn House Office Building. Upon entering the room, R/O warned the Suspects to cease and desist with their unlawful activities, which they did. After the Suspects left the room, R/O recognized one of the Suspects as a person of interest. A WALES/NCIC check confirmed he was in violation of his Stay Away Order. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
