**ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER - MISDEMEANOR**

**ADDITIONAL CHARGES: RESISTING ARREST**

R/O observed a vehicle traveling eastbound in the unit block of Columbus Circle, NE, fail to maintain its lane of travel. A traffic stop was conducted in the 300 block of Massachusetts Avenue, NE. A WALES/NCIC check revealed that the Suspect possessed a valid learner's permit in the District of Columbia but had no status in Maryland or Virginia. R/O-2 and R/O-3 responded to the scene to provide support due to the Suspect's verbally confrontational behavior during the traffic stop. R/O had the Suspect step outside of the vehicle. When R/O informed the Suspect that the vehicle would be towed, the Suspect attempted to walk back to the vehicle. R/O-2 told the Suspect to stop, at which point the Suspect threw his right shoulder in R/O-2's direction. The Suspect began physically resisting the officers while being handcuffed, resulting in several injuries to the officers. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
