**ADDITIONAL CHARGES:** TRAFFIC - PERMIT-NO VALID; POSS OPEN CONTAINER ALCOHOL - POCA

R/O, while on routine patrol in the 700 block of Sixth Street, SE, observed a vehicle failing to proceed on a green traffic signal. A traffic stop was conducted in the 200 block of Sixth Street, SE, after observing the vehicle fail to proceed through a second green traffic signal. While talking to the Suspect, R/O detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from their breath. R/O also observed what appeared to be an open container of alcohol in the Suspect's vehicle. R/O-2 arrived on scene to conduct SFSTs, however the Suspect refused to submit to testing. A WALES/NCIC check revealed the Suspect's permit was suspended in Virginia, with no status in Maryland or the District of Columbia. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
