ADDITIONAL CHARGES: POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE

ADDITIONAL CHARGE: UCSA-POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHENALIA - MISD

R/O conducted a welfare check on two individuals who were huddled in an alley in the unit block of E Street, NW. While approaching the individuals, one tried to conceal an object in his hand. R/O asked the Suspect what he was trying to conceal, and he handed R/O a bag containing a white rock substance along with a glass pipe. While conducting a search of the Suspect and their belongings, R/O discovered an additional clear pill pack containing a white powdery substance along with a straw with powder residue on the inside. A field test of the substances was conducted and they tested positive for cocaine. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
