TRAFFIC ACCIDENT - LEAVING SCENE-PROPERTY DAMAGE

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: TRAFFIC - DUI ALCOHOL OR DRUGS

R/O was flagged down in the unit block of F Street, NW, to investigate a hit and run in the 700 block of North Capitol Street, NW, by the Victim. The Victim stated the Suspect fled, leaving the scene without exchanging information. R/O entered the location and came out with the Suspect to conduct a further investigation. During the interview, R/O detected an odor of alcohol emitting from the Suspect's breath and person. SFSTs were conducted and, due to numerous signs of impairment, the Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. A search incident to arrest uncovered a torn plastic bag containing a white, powdery substance. CSS responded to Prisoner Processing to conduct a field test of the substance, which tested positive for cocaine.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: ASSAULT ON A POLICE/FIRE - FELONY DC CODE 22-405; LEWD, INDECENT OR OBSCENE ACTS; RESISTING ARREST

R/O responded to the U.S. Capitol Reflecting Pool to investigate a report of a man swimming nude. Upon arrival, R/O observed the unclothed Suspect in the pool, refusing to leave. After getting out of the pool and trying to locate his clothes, the Suspect acknowledged owning a pair of sneakers

discovered near the location, containing a white, powdery substance. R/O and multiple officers then attempted to handcuff the Suspect, but he aggressively resisted and attempted to bite a R/O. The white, powdery substance was field tested, and it tested positive methamphetamine. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: PAROLE VIOLATION

R/O was flagged down by a citizen reporting an assault in the 500 block of First Street, NW.
