A Witness confirmed that the Suspect struck and scratched the Complainant numerous times. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: USCA - OTHER; RESISTING ARREST; TRAFFIC ACCIDENT - LEAVING SCENE - PROPERTY DAMAGE

R/O observed a vehicle traveling westbound on Constitution Avenue, NE, matching the description of a vehicle involved in an accident and fleeing the scene at the intersection of Third Street and Constitution Avenue, NE. R/O conducted a traffic stop in the unit block of Constitution Avenue, NW. R/O advised the Suspect to step out of the vehicle. The Suspect became agitated, would not follow instructions and tried to walk away. R/O tried to get the Suspect to comply but he kept resisting. A WALES/NCIC check revealed the Suspect's permit was suspended in the District of Columbia with no status in Maryland or Virginia. During a search of the vehicle, R/O found two clear plastic bags containing a green leafy substance. A field test of the substance was conducted, and the substance

tested positive for THC. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

During the stop, S-2 became noncompliant and physically combative. A WALES/NCIC check of S-2 confirmed an active Stay Away order. Both Suspects were placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

SFSTs were conducted and, due to numerous signs of impairment, the Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
