TRAFFIC - MISUSE OF TAGS

The Defendant was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

STOLEN AUTO

During a search of the area, officers located a vehicle matching the description of the stolen auto parked in the 100 block of D Street, NE. R/O arrived on scene to find an individual in the vehicle. The vehicle was confirmed as the stolen auto, and the Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. CSS responded and processed the scene.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: RESISTING ARREST; FAILURE TO OBEY POLICE OFFICER

R/O observed an individual in the unit block of D Street, NW, with what appeared to be a brown joint in his hand. While R/O was conducting a WALES/NCIC check, the Suspect fled the scene. The Suspect was apprehended after resisting arrest and failing to comply with R/O's commands to stop in the unit block of Louisiana Avenue, NE. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: FUGITIVE FROM JUSTICE

R/O observed a vehicle traveling eastbound in the 300 block of Constitution Avenue, NW, matching the description of a vehicle listed as a Stolen Vehicle from an LPR match. R/O performed a tag check to confirm the vehicle was stolen. A traffic stop was conducted at 100 Louisiana Avenue, NW. A WALES/NCIC check revealed the Suspect had an outstanding Felony Arrest warrant, which was confirmed through USCP Communications. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. CSS responded and processed the scene.

TRAFFIC - DUI ALCOHOL OR DRUGS

ADDITIONAL CHARGE: UCSA-POSSESSION (OTHER)

R/O responded to the intersection of Second and East Capitol Streets, SE, to conduct a welfare check. Upon arrival, R/O observed the Suspect sitting in the vehicle with the engine running but not responding to any verbal commands. The Suspect eventually exited the vehicle and was observed staggering and was very unbalanced. SFSTs were conducted and, due to numerous signs of impairment, the Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing. During processing, R/O found a small baggy of a white, powdery substance in the Suspect's pocket. The substance was field tested, and it tested positive for cocaine.
