R/O observed multiple individuals disrupting normal business operations by chanting and blocking passage in a hallway of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. The Suspects were warned to cease and desist with their unlawful demonstration activities, but they refused to comply. Five Suspects were placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER; RESISTING ARREST

ADDITIONAL CHARGES: POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE - MARIJUANA; POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE - MDMA; POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE - SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS; RESISTING ARREST

R/O attempted to stop a Suspect he recognized as a Fugitive from Justice in the unit block of Massachusetts Avenue, NE. The Suspect fled, but was apprehended after a brief struggle with R/O. A large bag of a green, leafy substance was observed protruding from the Suspect's waistband. A WALES/NCIC check revealed an active warrant for Theft Scheme and Assault on a Police Officer out of Montgomery County, Maryland. Search incident to arrest revealed a clear zip bag containing a white, powdery substance, and a clear sandwich bag containing a brown, leafy substance. The substances were field tested, and they tested positive for marijuana, MDMA, and synthetic cannabinoids. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
