#### ADDITIONAL CHARGES: PPW-B - MISD

R/O observed the Suspect standing in the 400 block of New Jersey Avenue, NW, smoking a hand-rolled cigarette consistent with that of synthetic cannabinoids. R/O approached the Suspect, at which time the Suspect became agitated and aggressive, threw down the hand-rolled cigarette, and walked away. R/O advised the Suspect he was not free to leave. A field test of the substance was conducted, and it tested positive synthetic cannabinoids. During the search incident to arrest, R/O found a knife on the Suspect. CSS responded to process the scene. The Suspect was placed under arrest and transported to Headquarters for processing.
